## Building an empowering backpack for children's growth

### About the Project

With the Erasmus+ project PowerPack, we are working on something special: strengthening the personal, social and emotional development (PSED) of elementary school children. Through an interactive and cross-curricular approach, we aim to help children build more self-confidence, self-understanding and resilience - important building blocks for their well-being and future.

But we don't just focus on children. Teachers and parents/caregivers also play a crucial role. Therefore, within PowerPack, we are developing practical teaching materials, interactive tools and training guides that support them in guiding children on their growth path. This is how we make PSED a permanent and valuable part of primary education.

Materials and tools we are creating:

- PowerPack Roadmap: How to implement PSED in school-based education
- PowerPack Toolkit: An educational package including interactive learning materials for students and a teacher's guide.
- PowerPack Support: A support handbook to strengthen involvement and promotion among children, teachers and parents/caregivers.
